

## 21. VILLAGE VISIONS

Cllr Lyon proposed and Cllr Fairchild seconded that the June 2012 draft versions of the Visions for Haddenham and Aldreth should be accepted. Motion carried unanimously.

## 22. MATTERS TO REPORT

Cllr P Wilson advised the Council that she had "called in" the planning application for a development of affordable housing on land to the North of Northumbria Close to the District Council Planning Committee to ensure that all interested parties would be able to have their say on it.

Cllr Tindall suggested that the Full Council meetings should be moved to the room next door for September and October to see if this helps to cut down noise penetrating from other sessions being held in the Centre. He also wished to remind councillors to keep quiet when a person is already speaking as this contributes to the problems with hearing what is being said.

The Clerk was asked to find out how often the gullies in the village are cleaned and what the schedule of work is as there are particular problems with one opposite the Spar Shop and also in Glebe Way.

Cllr Norman mentioned the topper machine and this is due to be discussed at the Finance & Emergency meeting on 24<sup>th</sup> July.

The Clerk was asked to put a note under the windscreen of a vehicle parked on Parish Council land at the entrance to The Rampart asking the owner to remove it as it is hindering the grass cutting.

The Clerk advised that following a letter published in the July issue of Village VOICE in response to her article the previous month about dogs fouling in the Closed Cemetery she had composed a reply to be published in the September issue. This had been agreed with Cllrs Parr and Tindall.

The Clerk also advised that the Environmental Enforcement Officer had visited the Closed Cemetery on five occasions and all dog owners were carrying poo bags and he had not seen any widespread fouling in the area. (See Minutes MM 06/2012 Item 3b)
