

A specific issue might be the potential to light the mast and mark the guy wires with spherical orange markers.

3. We are also concerned that the Ouse Washes RAMSAR site may be replaced, in particular the site on the Sutton side of Haddenham fen may be relevant and we believe that ECDC ought to consult with the Environment Agency on this matter.

There are concerns that they have not consulted sufficiently with Ouse Washes Landscape Partnership and Great Ouse AONB.

Motion carried unanimously.

**14/00005/FUL 80 Hillrow, Haddenham:** Change of use to garden land in association with 80 Hillrow, Haddenham and erection of replacement outbuilding for domestic storage. Cllr Tindall proposed and Cllr Page seconded that there were concerns regarding the application:

1. The change of use to garden land needs more clarification.
2. A condition must be applied that the replacement building must be completely non residential and used purely for garden storage and hobby purposes and should not be connected to mains water.


Motion carried by a show of 9 hands. Cllr Goddard abstained.

**14/00164/FUL 6 Linden Way, Haddenham:** Single storey side extension. Cllr Tindall proposed and Cllr Parr seconded that there were no objections. Motion carried unanimously.
