8. INFORMATION FROM DISTRICT & COUNTY COUNCILLORS

Cllr P Wilson advised that the Ely Soham Dial-a-Ride AGM would be held on Tuesday 17th February. They have six options in mind to help them move forward and are reasonably hopeful that they will be able to continue. She had also attended a housing seminar by Sanctuary Hereward, which had been interesting.

Cllr G Wilson had attended a Corporate Governance & Finance meeting following the budget seminar and it had been agreed that £15,000, which had been allocated to ESDAR this year should become a be included in the budget for future years for community transport, also taking in the Newmarket area. Cllr Wilson had also managed to secure £40,000 in the budget for road safety issues. He had asked for the best public toilet awards to be re-introduced in Ely to give the cleaners some encouragement but this had not been approved, however a working party has been set up to look at improvements to the toilets, which are critical for tourists visiting the city. There may be some Sanctuary Community Awards funding of £5000 for Haddenham and one idea being investigated is the possible extension of the Recreation Field car park.

There was no report this month from County Cllr Hunt.
