

12. DRAFT ELY STATION GATEWAY SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT

It was agreed that councillors would make their response to the consultation as individuals. The Clerk will also advertise the consultation on the website and notice boards.

13. INTERNAL AUDIT BRIEF 2013/14

Cllr G Wilson proposed and Cllr Bush seconded that the Internal Audit Brief for 2013/14, as circulated to all members, should be approved. Motion carried unanimously.

14. REQUEST FROM HADDENHAM CONSERVATION SOCIETY TO HOLD A CAKE & PLANT STALL ON THE GREEN ON SATURDAY 3RD MAY 2014

Cllr Tindall proposed and Cllr Fairchild seconded that permission should be granted. Motion carried unanimously.

15. SPEEDWATCH SIGNS

Cllr G Wilson proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that three Speedwatch signs should be purchased at a cost of £60 each to be erected at the three main entrances to Haddenham. Motion defeated by a show of 10 hands against. Cllr P Wilson voted for and Cllr G Wilson abstained.

16. ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

(See Minutes FC 02/2014 Item 20) Guest speakers had been confirmed from Haddenham Local History Group, Haddenham WI, The Ark Toddler Group, Stop Berry Fen Wind Farm Group and Haddenham Youth Club and would attend to give a 10-minute talk each. It was agreed that questions could be asked afterwards whilst refreshments are being served. The Clerk had also requested reports from County Cllr Hunt, District Cllr Allen, Arkenstall Village Centre, Aldreth Community Association, Haddenham Library and the Pond Management Committee. Cllrs Wilson will also give their District Council reports. The draft agenda as circulated to all councillors was approved and will be signed and published as soon as possible.

17. REQUEST TO TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS

The Clerk had received a request from Mr David O Wallis of Southend-on-Sea to transfer Certificate of Exclusive Rights No. 62 into the name of his grandson Mr Alexander Owen Wallis who had agreed to take over the responsibility of Grave No. 513 (Mrs Olive Wallis). The original certificate had been granted in perpetuity and therefore there would be no further fees to be paid. Cllr Tindall proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that the request should be granted. Motion carried unanimously.

18. REQUEST FROM CIRCUS TYANNA TO VISIT HADDENHAM IN JUNE

Cllr Goddard proposed and Cllr Page seconded that permission should be granted for Circus Tyanna to visit the Recreation Field between the 11th and 15th June, subject to the usual conditions as laid down in previous years and in addition a £50 refundable deposit to ensure that all advertising posters are removed from the village and surrounding areas within 7 days of their departure. Motion carried unanimously.

19. BUILDINGS OF LOCAL INTEREST

(See Minutes FC 02/2014 Item 8 para 5) The Clerk advised that Haddenham Conservation Society would like to nominate the Closed Cemetery in Church Lane and Fairchild's Meadows to be included on the list. It was agreed that there were no objections subject to HCS filling out the necessary paperwork for nomination. Other buildings mentioned were the Bier House, War Memorial, Aldreth Village Centre, Arkenstall Village Centre and the Boundary Stone between Hillrow and Haddenham. The Clerk will give applications forms to the relevant people who made these suggestions.

20. BT CABINET ON THE GREEN

(See Minutes FC 01/2014 Item 18 para 8) The Clerk reported that the BT cabinet had been installed on The Green as part of the Connecting Cambridgeshire Project. The County Council had advised BT that they owned the land but Jez Reeve had located a document (Ref No. 204/U/33) signed on 20th March
