

The electrical recycling event held in February had resulted in a collection of 3455kgs, which will bring an income of £114.64 to the Parish. Over the past 18 months and 3 collections a total of 16 tonnes of electrical waste has been recycled and Paul Duggan of WISER would like to hold another event on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, date to be confirmed. A suggestion had been received from a parishioner regarding central collection points to prevent items being taken from the roadside by people other than the collection drivers and Paul had suggested that two bins could be provided if there is a lockable area where they could be stored but there is nowhere suitable in the village for this arrangement.

The Clerk reported that Zurich Municipal had advised that the case concerning subsidence at 20 Hop Row, Haddenham allegedly caused by a tree on the Recreation Field has now been closed. In light of the evidence available at the time it was found that no liability would attach and the claim was repudiated.

PCSO Annie Austin is being relocated to Littleport with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April because full time PCSOs are required to cover Ely, Soham and Littleport and part time PCSOs will cover the villages. The new PCSO for Haddenham is called Jo and it is hoped she will attend the Annual Parish Meeting with Annie to introduce herself.

The S106 Small Villages Grant Fund is open for applications; there is £33,469.21 available for Community Infrastructure Projects and £1370.83 for Public Open Spaces Projects.

The Clerk reminded councillors that the East Cambs Parish Conference would be held on 2<sup>nd</sup> April at Burwell.
