

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF HADDENHAM PARISH COUNCIL held on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2015 at 7.30pm at the Arkenstall Village Centre, Station Road, Haddenham, Cambs.**

1. **MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING** having been circulated to all members were taken as read. Cllr P Wilson proposed and Cllr G Wilson seconded that the minutes should be signed as a true record of the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

**2. MATTERS ARISING**

a. **Street Light in Bell Gardens:** (See Minutes FC 03/2015 Item 13 para 2) The Clerk had received confirmation from Balfour Beatty that the removal of the light in Bell Gardens would be put on hold but a week later it had been removed. On contacting BB she was told that it would cost the Parish Council £2,500 to have it reinstated. An email lodging a complaint about this and other issues surrounding the replacement lighting scheme has been sent to the County Council and a reply is awaited.

b. **Travellers:** (See Minutes FC 03/2015 Item 5 para 1) The Clerk reported that the travellers have now been moved on from Grangers Drove and Long Drove and all rubbish and mess has been cleared up by the District Council.

c. **Parking signs:** (See Minutes FC 03/2015 Item 2c) Nick Ball the District Council Neighbourhood Support Officer had contacted the Clerk to say he was not happy with the response from PCSO Annie about the proposed parking signs and he would take this up with someone higher up in the police.

d. **Boundary issue at Recreation Field:** (See Minutes FC 03/2015 Item 2d) Cllr Lyon and the Clerk had met with the new owner of 18 Hop Row and discussed the situation. He is consulting a surveyor and will contact the Clerk again as soon as he has an update.
