

- D. **Burial Areas:** Nothing to report.
- E. **Christmas Lights:** Cllr Page advised that he would be happy to continue to help with the lights although he does not intend to stand for election in May.
- F. **Environmental Overview:** Meeting to be arranged during May.
- G. **Street Lighting:** Nothing to report.
- H. **Aldreth Community Association:** Nothing to report.
- I. **Arkenstall Village Centre:** Nothing to report.
- J. **Haddenham Library:** Nothing to report.
- K. **Haddenham Youth Club:** (See Minutes FC 03/2015 Item 20) Cllr G Wilson had been unable to secure any help regarding a new youth leader for Haddenham but will continue to try other sources. The Baptist Church has organised a lorry to attend the Robert Arkenstall School on Tuesdays but this is aimed at a slightly younger age group than the previous club, however, membership is growing steadily each week. It was agreed that once the new council is in place in May a working group will be formed to draw up a plan for the way forward to provide a youth provision in the village.
- L. **Guppy's Pond:** Nothing to report.
- M. **Recreation:** A meeting will be arranged in May. Cllr Lyon will speak to Fergusons Ltd about driving over the Recreation Field in their vehicle.
- N. **Fairchild's Meadows:** The next meeting will be held on Monday 27th April.
- O. **Road Safety:** Complaints had been received regarding speeding in the High Street but it is difficult to carry out a Speedwatch session with cars parked along one side of the road. A session had been carried out in West End near Glebe Way and no cars were recorded speeding. Proposals for the next Minor Highways Bid were discussed at the last group meeting and investigations will be made into what could be done to alleviate the safety issues at Top Corner where cars consistently park illegally on the double yellow lines. The Clerk was also asked to chase Highways regarding the promised "SLOW" road markings on Sutton Road coming into the village near the Grunty Fen turning. The two items put forward for the Regulation 123 List Projects had been rejected as they had failed to score highly enough (See minutes FC 01/2015 Item 13). The Clerk was asked to write and point out that these were not bids but expressions of wish for projects now or at some time in the future and therefore they should still be included on the list.

10. REQUEST FROM BONFIRE COMMITTEE FOR FUNDING

A new Bonfire Committee has been formed and a request had been received for help in funding the event. Whilst the Council supports and hopes the event is a success, unfortunately there is no money available in the Grants budget for 2015/16. The Clerk will ask the Committee for a budget plan giving expected expenditure, income and possible shortfall to enable the Council to revisit the request in June and consider if it would be prepared to include some funding in the Precept for 2016/17.

11. REQUEST FROM CONSERVATION SOCIETY TO HOLD A CAKE STALL ON THE GREEN

Cllr Parr proposed and Cllr Hugo seconded that permission should be given to hold a cake stall on The Green on Saturday 2nd May from 9am until 12 noon. Motion carried unanimously.

12. PARISH ELECTION 2015
