

After further discussion Cllr Norman removed himself from the meeting.

Cllr Parr proposed and Cllr Hugo seconded that no objection to the application should be made for the following reasons: -

- There is no hard or photographic evidence to dispute or disprove the statement that a fence was already in place in 1996.
- To object to the application and possibly involve a court case could incur a severe financial cost to the Parish Council, which would be out of proportion to the value of the land in question and would not be a prudent use of parish money.
- This proposition reinforces the decision made in 2009 not to pursue the matter any further.

Motion carried unanimously.

28. MATTERS TO REPORT

Cllr Cheetham advised that a re-consultation on the Berry Fen Wind Farm application would be coming out at the end of May.

Cllr Hugo requested that the issue of funding for the Community First Responders should be put on the agenda for the June meeting to be reconsidered.
