Cllr Smith raised a query regarding an area of grass in Chewells Lane, which has not been cut and was advised that the Clerk has written to Kirk Builders as it still belongs to them and is not the responsibility of the County, District or Parish Councils.

Surface dressing work is planned in Hillrow on 10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> July and this will mean a road closure for that period.

The War Memorial has been cleaned and repointed but unfortunately during a heavy rain shower some of the cleaning fluid had splashed the surrounding grass and also flowers planted in the trough by Mr & Mrs Chapman and killed them. Mr & Mrs Chapman have now replanted the trough and the Council wished to thank them for this. The Clerk is liaising with the cleaning company regarding compensation for the damage.

An appeal has been made to the Secretary of State against the decision of East Cambs District Council to refuse to grant planning permission for the erection of up to 4 dwellings on the Builders Yard at Hod Hall Lane. This will be discussed further at the next planning meeting on 23<sup>rd</sup> June.

The Friends of Haddenham had sent their thanks to the Council for allowing them to sow wildflower seeds on The Mound at the Recreation Field. The Councillors are very pleased with the beautiful show of wildflowers and wished to congratulate and thank the Friends for their efforts.

Cllr Norman advised that the Fen Ride would take place on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> June, starting from The Green at 2.00pm. Spaces are still available.
