#### 9. INFORMATION FROM DISTRICT & COUNTY COUNCILLORS

Cllr Smith reported that REG Windpower had withdrawn the Berry Fen wind farm planning application. The Planning Officer had already recommended refusal for many reasons. The anemometer mast is still up and the District Council will write to the managing director of REG and ask for it to be removed as soon as possible.

The appeal by Gladman's for 128 houses to be built in Witchford had been upheld and permission granted.

There will be a public consultation on the proposed leisure centre in Ely, information relating to this can be found on the District Council website.

Cllr Cheetham reported that there had been some issues in Witchford over the past week concerning a Christian convention for travellers but they should be moving on at the end of the week.
