

## 12. PLANNING GROUP TERMS OF REFERENCE

Cllr Smith proposed and Cllr Morris seconded that the Terms of Reference, as presented, should be adopted subject to paragraph 5 under Process being amended to read:

“All councillors shall be notified of the meeting and if they attend they will have voting rights (effectively they are all de facto members of the Planning Committee when it convenes). The four members of the current Planning Group shall attend. The quorum for the Planning Committee shall be four”.

**Motion carried unanimously.**

## 13. PLANNING GROUPS MEMBERSHIP

Cllr Parr proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that membership of the Planning Groups should be as follows:

## 14. REVIEW OF ALLOTMENT REGULATIONS

Cllr G Wilson proposed and Cllr Cheetham seconded that the amended Allotment Regulations, as presented, should be approved and re-adopted with immediate effect. Motion carried by a show of 10 hands. Cllr Norman was against.

## 15. REVIEW OF BURIAL FEES

Cllr P Wilson proposed and Cllr Parr seconded that the current burial fees should remain unchanged. Motion carried unanimously.

## 16. REVIEW OF HADDENHAM CEMETERY REGULATIONS

Cllr P Wilson proposed and Cllr Parr seconded that the Cemetery Regulations, as presented, should be approved and re-adopted with immediate effect. Motion carried unanimously.

## 17. COMMUNITY LAND TRUST

A discussion paper submitted by Cllrs Cheetham, Hugo and Smith was considered and it was agreed that the Parish Council would explore the process of setting up a Community Land Trust for Haddenham. Cllr Cheetham will enquire about the District Council funding for carrying out a feasibility study and the Clerk will invite Cllr Charles Roberts from Stretham Parish Council to attend the next meeting in September to share his experiences from the Stretham Community Land Trust.

## 18. MATTERS TO REPORT

Cllr Cheetham asked for consideration to be given to implementing road safety measures at Top Corner and Cllr Lyon advised that he is awaiting a suggested plan from the Highways Department.

Cllr Goddard enquired if there was any news on the rubbish and asbestos dumped along the old railway track. The Clerk advised that it has now been reported to the Countryside Access Team and she is awaiting a reply.
