Cllr Ray had carried out a lot of research into what is available and advised that the new equipment would cost around £1000 and this was agreed. Cllr Ray was thanked for his input and advice.

#### 8. CORRESPONDENCE

A letter of thanks had been received from Mr & Mrs Mustill, expressing their appreciation to the Council for lobbying the District Council and recommending refusal of the Berry Fen Wind Farm application. They are greatly relieved that the turbines will not blight the villages and rural surroundings.

The County Council had written regarding the operational lighting times for many of the lights they own, along with levels to which they would be dimmed, but advised that there will be no changes in Haddenham & Aldreth at this time.
