

19. MOTION TO DISBAND WAYMAN'S PITS WORKING PARTY

Cllr Parr proposed and Cllr Cheetham seconded that the Wayman's Pits Working Party should be disbanded and integrated into the Environmental Overview Group. Motion carried unanimously. There were two public volunteer members on the old working party, Chris Prescott and Mike Smith and a letter will be sent to explain the new arrangements and that they will still be invited to attend meetings and be involved.

20. REFURBISHMENT OF ROCKING HORSE

Cllr Parr proposed and Cllr Page seconded that retrospective approval should be given for refurbishment work to the rocking horse at Aldreth Play Area. The work had been necessary to allow it to remain in the play area and Wicksteed Leisure had repaired and brought it up to safety standards at a cost of £676 + VAT. Motion carried unanimously.

21. HADDENHAM WEBSITE POLICY

A draft policy relating to linked sites on the Haddenham website was considered. Cllr Hugo proposed and Cllr Parr seconded that the policy should be approved and adopted. Robert Bush will be asked to post the policy as soon as possible and remove any links that do not comply with it.

22. HADDENHAM PHONE BOX

A request had been received from Brian Fairchild asking the Council to consider putting a defibrillator machine in the old telephone box at Top Corner as he felt this would be a good idea in a remote village and better use of the box. Cllr Smith proposed and Cllr Norman seconded that the logistics regarding key holders and responsible trained people would be impractical and the box should be left as it is. Motion carried unanimously. The Clerk will advise Brian of the decision and also advise that Haddenham Galleries administer the box on behalf of the Parish Council for village organisations to advertise their events. Cllr Hugo felt that if the Council was to consider funding a machine it would be better supplied to the Community First responders.

24. CONSULTATION ON FURTHER MODIFICATIONS TO THE EAST CAMBRIDGESHIRE LOCAL PLAN

The Council agrees with the arrangements set out in the consultation and this will be communicated to the Principal Forward Planning Officer.

25. ADDITIONAL WATER TANKS AT ALLOTMENT SITES

Cllr Parr proposed and Cllr Haigh seconded that an order should be issued to M & J Drury Building and Maintenance to supply and install two new water tanks at the Burial Ground Site and one at the Recreation Field Site at a cost of £1436.75 + VAT. Motion carried unanimously.
