

Cllr Norman reported that a resident in West End had had two bow top caravan wheels stolen from his garden.

Cllr G Wilson is dealing with a quote for repairs to the zip wire.

The Clerk advised that she had been contacted by Graham Nolan of Sanctuary Hereward regarding possible community funding and any Parish Council projects coming up that might benefit from it. She had mentioned Newtown Pocket Park and the refurbishment of the Pavilion and these will be noted in Graham's budget plan. At this time there is no indication of how much funding would be available and it is in no way linked to the development at land adjacent to Northumbria Close.

(See Minutes FC 04/2014 Item 16) Cllr Norman and the Clerk have obtained the relevant plans for the areas of land to be registered and over the next couple of weeks it is hoped that Cllrs Lyon and Norman will help the Clerk to measure and mark out the correct boundaries on the pond sites. Purchase of the plans has incurred an expenditure of £188.91 + VAT but is considerably less than engaging the services of an agent. She has also been gathering relevant information from past minutes to help prove the ownership of the areas. Once the boundaries are marked she will then be in a position to meet with the solicitor.

Heating oil had been stolen from the tank belonging to Little Ted's Day Nursery and the thieves had gained access through the allotments but unfortunately there is little that could be done to stop this. The Clerk had sent the owner some advice from e-cops on precautions that can be put in place to protect the tank.
