

17. MATTERS TO REPORT

Cllr Bayes requested an agenda item for the next meeting on 11th November to discuss setting up an online discussion group.

Cllr Goddard wished to remind everyone that the Haddenham Bonfire Event would be held on 6th November at Fairchild's Meadows and the Remembrance Service would be held on Sunday 8th November at 2.30pm at The Green. Cllr Goddard will lay the poppy wreath on behalf of the Council.

Cllr Cheetham requested that the Parish Council should send a letter to REG Windpower asking for the anemometer mast in Berry Fen to be removed.

Cllr G Wilson advised that he is looking into funding for the Pavilion refurbishment and has spoken to WREN. He will give an update at the next Recreation meeting.

The Local Highways Improvement Bid for 2016/17 will be discussed at the Road Safety meeting on 21st October.

Cllr Parr advised that a Speedwatch session was planned for 16th October in Station Road. The session held last month had caught a large tractor speeding in Hillrow.

Cllr Tindall advised that a resident in Froize End would like to enquire about having a grass area on Nelson's Lane tarmaced to provide a car parking space. He was advised that this would need to be taken up with County Highways.

Cllr Tindall also asked if notification had been received that the pavements in Lester Drive were going to be resurfaced but the Clerk advised that she had not been advised of the work.


Cllr Smith reported that posters had been put up at the Recreation Field advertising a circus visiting Cottenham and direction signs for the Steam Rally had still not been taken down in Station Road. The Clerk will chase this up.

Long Drove is undergoing some repairs by the County Council.
