7. CORRESPONDENCE

A letter had been received from the Traffic Commissioner advising that the Parish Council's objections to the Mick George Operating Centre at Mepal Quarry due to the potential increase in the amount of heavy traffic passing through the village could not be taken into consideration because the matters fall outside of his legislative jurisdiction. It also advised that he had decided to grant the use of the operating centre.

Electoral Review meetings will be held on 19th November at 2.30pm in the Council Chamber, Fenland Hall, March and 24th November at 2.30pm in the Council Chamber, South Cambridgeshire Hall, Cambourne.

Fields in Trust are running an initiative for War Memorials and the land they stand on to be protected for perpetuity and this will be considered further by the Environmental Overview Group.

An idea from a group of villagers to hold a beer festival event next year was favourably received by the Council and Toby Bush has been invited to attend the next Recreation Group meeting to discuss this further and explore the possibility of using the Pavilion and Recreation Field. Cllr Goddard mentioned that he had also been approached by a resident regarding organising a fireworks event as sadly the Bonfire Committee had held its last event on 7th November due to lack of funds and volunteers.
