8. POLICE REPORT

10th Dec 2012 – 10th Jan 2013

An outboard motor was stolen from a dry stored boat at Hermitage Marina at Earith Bridge sometime between 6th and 8th December. Over the month PCSO Annie has carried out several high visibility patrols in Haddenham & Aldreth and the only issues for concern have been illegal parking. She has monitored the crossroads on a regular basis and has spoken to several drivers for illegal and inconsiderate parking and also had to ask someone to move because they had parked over a resident's gateway. Annie has also visited the sheltered housing scheme at Camping Close on two or three occasions to check everything is quiet and there are no concerns to be dealt with. A handbag that had been stolen from a property in Hop Row had been recovered and returned to the owner during the early New Year period.
