#### 13. REQUEST FOR BROWNIES TO VISIT WAYMAN'S PITS

Cllr Fairchild proposed and Cllr G Wilson seconded that permission should be granted for the Brownies to visit Wayman's Pits one evening in June to carry out maintenance work to the trees planted in November, erect a commemorative plaque and hold a picnic. Motion carried unanimously.

#### 14. FEAST'S GREEN WALL

(See Minutes MM 02/2013 Item 8) Cllr G Wilson had met with the District Council Building Inspector to look at the wall and in his opinion it is completely safe and could be left for another year without any problem because it is not dangerous. He had advised on what remedial work would be required and this would involve removing some of the top layers of bricks, possibly 7 - 8 rows, then re-using some of them to cap along the top. He had also advised that there would be no need to build piers to strengthen it. Cllr Page had also sought a second opinion from an expert in this field and he had independently given the Council the same advice. Cllr P Wilson proposed and Cllr Goddard seconded that now the Council has a clear idea of what work is required quotes should be sought and the matter discussed again once these are to hand. It was also suggested that the spare bricks could be sold to help meet the cost of the repairs. Cllr Fairchild will remove the orange netting from around the wall at his earliest convenience. Cllr Norman also raised the issue of the footpath to run up to The Green and the Road Safety Group will examine this.

#### 15. ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

The draft agenda as presented by the Clerk was accepted. The Clerk also asked for reports from group chairmen to be submitted to her by Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April.

#### 16. REQUEST FROM HADDENHAM CONSERVATION SOCIETY

Cllr Fairchild proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that permission should be granted for the Conservation Society to hold its annual cake and plant sale on The Green on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May. Motion carried unanimously.

#### 17. BLOSSOMS & BYGONES

Cllr Fairchild proposed and Cllr Bush seconded that the Parish Council should support an application for Haddenham High Street to be closed from Camping Close to Top Corner between the hours of 12 noon and 5.30pm on Blossoms & Bygones Day to enable additional events to take place to mark the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the opening of the Robert Arkenstall School.

#### 18. FIELDS IN TRUST DEED OF DEDICATION

(See Minutes MM 02/2013 Item 3b) The Clerk advised that the Deed is now being processed and it would appear that part of that process includes the registration of the Recreation Field with the Land Registry Department. A commemorative plaque will be supplied to be erected on the Pavilion and the Clerk will also request a Royal Oak sapling to be planted on the field.
