

23. ANNUAL REPORT 2012/13

Cllr Hugo proposed and Cllr Goddard seconded that the draft report presented by the Clerk should be approved subject to the addition of a copy of the Balance Sheet for the 2012/13 accounts. Motion carried unanimously.

24. ARKENSTALL CENTRE TOILET UPGRADES

Cllr Fairchild proposed and Cllr Parr seconded that the Parish Council should support the project to upgrade the toilets at the Centre, projected cost to be in the region of £33,000 and apply for grant funding. Also that the Council should agree to re-allocate the Section 106 funding of £6000, which had previously been approved for the heating upgrade and also approve the use of £5000 Precepted funds for the Centre to be put towards the project. Motion carried unanimously.

25. HADDENHAM LIBRARY LEASE

Cllr Fairchild proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that when the County Council lease on the Library premises expires in September the Parish Council should enter into a lease with the Arkenstall Centre on the same terms and fees to allow the building to continue to be used as a library by the Friends of Haddenham Library. Motion carried unanimously.

26. DOG AND LITTER BINS REVIEW

This item will be discussed at the next Environmental Overview meeting in early June and then come back to Full Council with a recommendation.

27. VILLAGE VOICE DELIVERY

(See Minutes MM 04/2013 Item 14) The Clerk advised that the magazines should be ready for collection on 29th/30th May and she will get them batched up and ready for delivery as soon as possible. Councillors will do their best to get them out as close to the 1st June as possible.

28. TREES AT NON-CONFORMIST BURIAL GROUND

(See Minutes MM 04/2013 Item 10D) The Clerk had received permission from the Tree Officer to go ahead with the work on the three trees. Cllr Norman proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that an order should be issued to Conway Tree Specialists to carry out the work at a cost of £200. Motion carried unanimously.

29. STREET MAP IN ALDRETH

Cllr Fairchild proposed and Cllr Parr seconded that permission should be given to Aldreth Community Association to move the Aldreth Street Map from its current location up to the Aldreth Village Centre. Motion carried unanimously.

30. PLANNING MINUTES PM 05/2013

Due to the changeover of Planning Committees the minutes of the last meeting were presented to the Full Council for approval. Cllr Haigh proposed and Cllr Page seconded that the minutes should be signed as a true record of the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

31. PLANNING APPLICATION 13/00213/FUL 2 LINDEN WAY, HADDENHAM (AMENDMENT)

Also due to the changeover of Planning Committees and short timescale for a reply this amendment had been brought to Full Council for consideration. The amendment involved changes to front elevation including a reduction in size. Cllr Fairchild proposed and Cllr Page seconded that as the amendment had addressed previous concerns of the Parish Council there were no objections. Motion carried unanimously.
