

- H. Arkenstall Village Centre:** The next meeting will be held on Tuesday 16th July. The sub committees meet regularly and hope to improve the running of the Centre. A mass garage sale is planned for August to help with fund raising.
- I. Haddenham Youth Club:** It is expected that a member of the Club will attend the next Recreation meeting.
- J. Haddenham Library:** Cllr Goddard reported that unfortunately the planned Picture Show had had to be cancelled.
- K. Recreation:** The next meeting will be held on Monday 12th August. An emergency repair to the large skatepark ramp had been authorised at a cost of £550 due to the side having been smashed in. Cllr G Wilson is still working on the refurbishment project for Aldreth Play Area and Cllr Norman asked for the Council to have sight of the plans when they are drawn up. Quotations for window cleaning at the Pavilion will be obtained ready for the meeting on 12th August. (See Minutes MM 06/2013 Item 10P).
- L. Street Lighting:** Cllr Smith reported that Balfour Beatty has started the County Council upgrades in Metcalfe Way and Lode Way and they are only replacing lanterns not whole columns.

There were no new projects to be discussed.

12. STRAW LORRIES

Taking into account the concerns expressed by the residents during Public Participation it was agreed that the Clerk should write to County Highways and County Cllr Hunt highlighting the issues raised, i.e. straw on the road, blocked drains, speed and the fact that drivers are generally ignoring the County Councils preferred route along the A10. She will also point out that the signs at Stretham roundabout only show March and do not mention Sutton. In addition she will write to John Stannage at the straw burning plant to make him aware of the issues raised. She advised that her contact at Highways has already written to the owner of the overhanging trees at the top of Station Road asking for them to be trimmed back to avoid them sweeping across the top of the loaded lorries. Cllr G Wilson will also raise the issue at the Neighbourhood Panel Meeting on Monday evening.

13. PURCHASE OF DOG BIN

Cllr Tindall proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that a new dog bin should be purchased from Glasdon UK Ltd at a cost of £176.54, to be installed in Aldreth Road near Cllr Norman's orchard. He will be consulted on the exact location once it is ready for installation. Motion carried unanimously.

14. LIBRARY LEASE

The Clerk reported that there appears to have been an error in the recording of the payment periods for the Library Lease and HPC Office Rent and in fact the last payment made in May 2013 was for the year 2011/12, which means there will be a further invoice from the County Council for 2012/13 to be settled at the end of the lease in October. Cllr P Wilson proposed and Cllr Tindall seconded that this should be accepted. Motion carried unanimously.

15. CALOR GAS EVENT

Cllr G Wilson proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that permission should be given for Calor Gas to hold a promotional event on the area of The Green outside the doctors surgery on Friday 23rd August between 8.00am and 8.00pm. The Clerk was instructed to ask for a fee of £100 or to suggest that Calor might like to sponsor a dog bin. Motion carried unanimously.

16. PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETINGS

Cllr Goddard proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that with immediate effect agendas and minutes relating to Planning Committee meetings should be distributed to all councillors, with the exception of Cllr Norman, electronically. Motion carried unanimously.
