## 8. POLICE REPORT

8<sup>th</sup> October – 11<sup>th</sup> November

PCSO Annie visited a dog walker in Haddenham on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> October to give words of advice following an incident that day. On Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> October a search was carried out for a 14 year old lad who had disappeared from his new foster carers in Haddenham at approx 11:30am he was eventually found late afternoon, safe and well in Wisbech. A patrol was carried in Haddenham later that day. House to house enquiries were conducted in West End on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> October following the theft of approx £3000 worth of horse harness and a 'Queenie' stove from a Romany Caravan that was being restored.
