

**12. NEIGHBOURHOOD PANEL SERVICE REVIEW**

The future of the Neighbourhood Panels is being reviewed and the Parish Council agreed that if the Panels cease it would be in favour of an alternative twice-yearly event to engage parish councils and other public sector organisations, preferably to be held on a Saturday morning.

**13. COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY**

An update on what percentage of funding Parish Councils can expect from the Community Infrastructure Levy had been received and the Council was also asked to respond to two questions:

**(1) Should the A14 Improvement Project be included on the Regulation 123 list and benefit from CIL funding?** Cllr Hugo proposed and Cllr Bush seconded that the Council would not support this. Motion carried by a show of 7 hands. Cllr Norman was against and Cllr Haigh abstained.

**(2) Should the Ely Southern Bypass be included on the Regulation 123 list and benefit from CIL funding?** Cllr Page proposed and Cllr Smith seconded that the Council would support this. Motion carried unanimously.

**14. NO2 AIR QUALITY MONITORING REPORT 2012**

The monitoring report from the Nitrogen Dioxide diffusion tubes for 2012 had been received and the data shows that the air quality in Haddenham is quite good, fairly typical of East Cambs as a whole and much better than many other parts of Cambridgeshire. The results were broadly comparable to those from 2011. The monitoring has continued throughout 2013 but will be put on the agenda for January to discuss if it should continue in 2014.

**15. DECEMBER FULL COUNCIL MEETING DATE**

This item was cancelled, as there was no need to change the date.

**16. MATTERS TO REPORT**

Cllrs Lyon and Norman had met with Pam Joyce, County Highways Officer to discuss the feasibility of installing a footpath from Feast's Green to The Green, which was subject to a Section 106 condition in the original planning permission for Great Mill View. Pam had responded that due to a lack of required width, the cost to move an existing utility pole, issues which would render pedestrians more vulnerable at certain points of the proposed footpath and the fact that the County Council would not adopt and maintain the footpath she would advise that the project should be reconsidered.

The Clerk had received correspondence from Zurich Municipal regarding the ongoing issue of the Horse Chestnut tree and alleged subsidence at 20 Hop Row. (See Minutes MM 03/2013 Item 2b). Zurich advised that it is awaiting a response from the claimant's solicitors and has increased its total reserve for this issue to £22,500. Cllrs Lyon and Norman had received a copy of the correspondence and they will look at it in more detail.

The Clerk advised that the legal fees for the Haddenham Library Lease would be £120.00 + VAT and will confirm to Christine Battersby that the Council had already agreed to cover the costs. (See Minutes MM 08/2103 Item 14)
