

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE OF HADDENHAM PARISH COUNCIL held on Wednesday 13th March 2013 at 7.00pm at the Arkenstall Village Centre, Station Road, Haddenham, Cambs.

Attendance: Cllrs Fairchild, Goddard, Haigh, Hugo, Lyon, Norman, Page and Smith.

In the absence of Cllr Parr (Chairman) the meeting was chaired by Cllr Fairchild.

1. **MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING** having been circulated to all members were taken as read. Cllr Page proposed and Cllr Lyon seconded that the minutes should be signed as a true record of the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

2. **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** were received from Cllr Parr – family bereavement.

3. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

There were none.

4. **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

There were no members of the public in attendance.

5. **PLANNING**

13/00091/FUL 5A Nelsons Lane, Haddenham: Proposed single storey extensions to dwelling and erection of new outbuilding. Cllr Lyon proposed and Cllr Haigh seconded that there were no objections. Motion carried unanimously.

13/00092/FUL 2 Great Mill View, Haddenham: Single storey extension. Cllr Haigh proposed and Cllr Page seconded that there were no objections. Motion carried unanimously.

12/00931/FUL Willow Farm, Hillrow Causeway, Haddenham (Amendment): Replacement of existing subsidised bungalow with one and a half storey four-bedroom house. Amendment to involve replacing existing bungalow with single storey dwelling, rather than a two-storey dwelling. Cllr Page proposed and Cllr Goddard seconded that there were no objections. Motion carried unanimously.

6. **MATTERS TO REPORT**

The Clerk reported that an appeal had been made by the Sanctuary Group to the Secretary of State against the decision of the District Council to refuse to grant planning permission for the proposed development at Land North of 9 – 11 Northumbria Close, Haddenham. A submission from the Parish Council to the Secretary of State will be formalised at the next meeting.


The Clerk also reported that the Planning Inspectorate had allowed the appeal and granted planning permission for change of use from builders yard and offices to three pitches for gypsy/travellers at Hod Hall Lane, Haddenham.

It had come to the attention of the Council that an application had been made by Mick George Ltd to change the existing licence to add an operating centre to keep 40 goods vehicles and 4 trailers at Mepal Landfill, Witcham Meadlands, Block Fen, Mepal. A letter had been sent strongly objecting to this application and the proposed changes.
