

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE OF HADDENHAM PARISH COUNCIL held on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2015 at 7.45pm at Haddenham Library, Station Road, Haddenham, Cambs.**

1. **MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING** having been circulated to all members were taken as read. Cllr Goddard proposed and Cllr Smith seconded that the minutes should be signed as a true record of the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

4. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

The Clerk advised that planning application 15/00205/CLE Land Rear of Bradfields Barn had not been received for consideration and therefore Cllr Cheetham did not declare an interest.

6. **PLANNING**

**15/00124/FUL 5 High Street, Haddenham:** A new portable building/office, to be used for sorting post/mail by the Royal Mail. Cllr Hugo proposed and Cllr Parr seconded that the Parish Council would approve and support this proposed development but there are concerns about additional traffic entering and leaving the yard and the impact this might have on the existing problem of illegal parking at the top of the High Street. Motion carried by a show of 6 hands. Cllr Norman was against and Cllrs Goddard and Haigh abstained.

7. **MATTERS TO REPORT**

The anemometer mast has been erected in Berry Fen but two of the conditions relating to swan deflectors and warning lights for aviation have not been complied with. The Clerk will write to the Planning Officer pointing this out and ask for it to be investigated.

The Clerk had received an acknowledgement that her query from Minutes PM 02/2015 Item 7 para 2 is being looked into.
