

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE OF HADDENHAM PARISH COUNCIL  
held on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> July 2013 at 7.45pm at Haddenham Library, Station Road, Haddenham, Cambs.**

**Attendance:** Cllrs Goddard, Lyon (Chairman), Tindall, G Wilson and P Wilson

**1. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING** having been circulated to all members were taken as read. Cllr G Wilson proposed and Cllr Goddard seconded that the minutes should be signed as a true record of the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

**2. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** were received from Cllrs Haigh and Page – on holiday and Cllr Hugo – work commitments.

**3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Cllr G Wilson requested it to be minuted that he is also a member of the District Council Planning Committee and although he would take part in discussions regarding the following applications he would keep an open mind until they have been considered at District level.

**4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

It was agreed that those members of the public present would be allowed to speak whilst the applications were being discussed.

**5. PLANNING**

**13/00342/FUL Land between 58 & 60A High Street, Haddenham (Amendment):** Erection of detached dwelling. Amendment to involve details of boundary treatment to define pedestrian visibility splays, surfacing to front and revised red edge site plan. Cllr P Wilson proposed and Cllr Tindall seconded that the existing entrance should be retained as it does not make sense to create a new dropped kerb when there is already one in place and the existing telegraph pole would make the new entrance narrower. Motion carried unanimously.

**13/00372/FUL 6 Linden Close, Haddenham (Amendment):** Single storey rear extension and loft conversion. Amendment to involve the removal of dormer window. Cllr P Wilson proposed and Cllr Goddard seconded that there were no objections. Motion carried unanimously.

**13/00499/ESF Solar Farm South of Mingay Farm, Twentypence Road, Wilburton:** Extension to existing renewable energy solar farm, to include the installation of solar panels, transformer rooms and plant, access and on-site tracks, security fencing and cameras, landscaping and other associated works. Cllr P Wilson proposed and Cllr Tindall seconded that there were no objections to the plan but the Parish Council would suggest that the developers should consider the benefits of making good the small stretch of road called Fen Side off Twentypence Road at the North end of the existing site to bring it up to standard with the rest of the footpath. They would also like to suggest the consideration of some solar panels being donated to Haddenham School in the same way as was originally done for Wilburton School. Motion carried unanimously.
