

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE OF HADDENHAM
PARISH COUNCIL held on Thursday 25th September 2014 at 7.30pm at Haddenham
Library, Station Road, Haddenham, Cambs.**

Attendance: Cllrs Cheetham, Goddard, Haigh, Hugo, Lyon (Chairman), Page, Tindall,
G Wilson and P Wilson.

1. **MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING** having been circulated to all members were taken as read. Cllr Tindall proposed and Cllr G Wilson seconded that the minutes should be signed as a true record of the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

2. **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

There were none.

3. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Cllr G Wilson requested it to be minuted that he is also a member of the District Council Planning Committee and although he would take part in discussions regarding the following applications he would keep an open mind until they have been considered at District level.

Cllr Tindall declared a personal interest in applications 14/00734/FUL 31 Lode Way, Haddenham and 14/00936/FUL 37 Lode Way, Haddenham.

4. **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

There were no members of the public in attendance.

5. **PLANNING**

14/00734/FUL 31 Lode Way, Haddenham (Amendment): Replacement 5 bed dwelling with detached double garage. Amendment involves amended access to rear fields. Cllr Cheetham proposed and Cllr Page seconded that the Parish Council's previous comments submitted for this application still stand but there were no objections to this amendment relating to the amended access. Motion carried by a show of 7 hands. Cllrs G Wilson and Tindall abstained.

14/00936/FUL 37 Lode Way, Haddenham: Proposed single storey extension and balcony. Cllr Goddard proposed and Cllr P Wilson seconded that there were no objections. Motion carried by a show of 7 hands. Cllrs G Wilson and Tindall abstained.

14/00962/FUL 80 Hillrow, Haddenham: Change of use to garden land in association with 80 Hillrow, Haddenham and erection of replacement outbuilding (revised design from planning permission 14/00005/FUL) for domestic storage. Cllr Hugo proposed and Cllr Tindall seconded that there were no objections but the proposed building must be completely non residential and used purely for domestic storage purposes and should not be connected to mains water. Motion carried by a show of 8 hands. Cllr G Wilson abstained.

6. **MATTERS TO REPORT**

Cllr Tindall reported that a digger had been carrying out some excavation work for archaeological purposes on the proposed site for the 100 houses at Wilburton Road.

7. **DATE OF NEXT MEETING**

The next meeting will be arranged as necessary.
