

**21. WALL AT FEAST'S GREEN**

The wall was looked at on the walkabout (see Minutes MM 07/2012 Item 20) and following that the Clerk had contacted Christine Battersby to ask for clarification on ownership of the section adjacent to No 19 The Green but she was unable to do this. The Clerk had subsequently written to the owners of No. 19 advising that the Council may decide to take the wall down at some point and is conscious that their house number and mirror are attached to it. To date she had heard nothing from them. Cllr Lyon will visit the owners to ensure they are fully aware of what the Council is planning to do. The issue of the continuation of the footpath was also mentioned and the Clerk had written to Andy Graham, the developer, who still feels that the path would need to stop in a very dangerous position. It was agreed that nothing further could be done about the footpath until the future of the wall had been decided.

**22. PROVISION OF DOG BAGS AND DISPENSERS**

A resident had requested the Council to consider providing dog bag dispensers and bags at other parish open spaces in addition to the one already provided at Fairchild's Meadows. It was reported that some dog owners abuse the dispenser at the Meadows by taking big amounts of bags when it is not necessary. Cllr Smith proposed and Cllr Page seconded that it would be a better use of money to provide additional dog bins instead of dispensers and bags. Motion carried unanimously.

**23. ANNUAL RETURN 2011/12**

The Clerk reported that the annual audit had been carried out for 2011/12 and there were no items to be actioned. Cllr G Wilson proposed and Cllr Norman seconded that this report was accepted. Cllr G Wilson also wished to propose a vote of thanks to the Clerk for keeping the accounts in good order. Motion carried unanimously.

**24. COMMUNITY RIGHT TO CHALLENGE PROTOCOL**

It was agreed that no comments would be returned on this consultation.

**25. INSURANCE COVER FOR NEW PLAY EQUIPMENT**

Cllr Smith proposed and Cllr Lyon seconded that no additional insurance cover should be taken out to cover the new play equipment. Motion carried unanimously.

**26. PURCHASE OF LITTER BIN**

Cllr Lyon proposed and Cllr G Wilson seconded that an order should be placed with Glasdon UK for a Community Litter Bin at a cost of £200.63 + fixings to be sited in Haddenham Play Area near the new gate. Motion carried unanimously.

**28. PARISH COUNCIL WEBSITE**

(See Minutes MM 05/2012 Item 27) Cllr Bush had developed a website for councillors to consider and feedback suggestions over the last couple of months and all were happy with what had been presented. He is now waiting to complete the transfer of the Haddenham.org domain name and then hopes to go live around the 22<sup>nd</sup> September. Village VOICE has promised a front-page advert for the October issue. Cllr Lyon proposed and Cllr Hugo seconded that this should be authorised. Motion carried unanimously.

**29. COMMITTEE/WORKING PARTY STRUCTURE**

Cllr Lyon had submitted proposals to re-organise the structure of the committees and working parties within the Council. It was agreed that due to the late time and the need for this to be discussed more fully it would be deferred until the October meeting.
