

Examination of East Cambridgeshire Local Plan

Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice of further hearing session

Michael Hetherington BSc. (Hons) MA MRTPI MCIEEM an Inspector from the Planning Inspectorate is conducting the examination of the East Cambridgeshire Plan. His role is to consider whether the Plan is sound and whether the requirements of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) and associated regulations have been met.

Following a further hearing session held in June 2014, the Inspector has asked that the Council address his concerns relating to 5 year housing supply outlined in his Interim Conclusions paper (dated 14th July 2014). The Council is therefore undertaking additional public consultation on a number of proposed further modifications to the Local Plan. The Council is consulting on the proposed further modifications to the Local Plan between 10th September 2014 and Wednesday 22nd October 2014 (5pm). In order to address any issues arising from the public consultation on these proposed modifications, a further hearing session is scheduled to be held on:

- Tuesday 11th November 2014

Please note it is possible that a second date may be required on 10th November 2014 - this will be confirmed on the Council's website nearer the time.

The hearing session will focus on the representations made on the Council's current proposed modifications to the Local Plan.
