

It is hoped that the narrowing effect will slow the traffic, such that any close encounters at the Hop Row junction will be minimised.

We are now at the point when the County Council will work the proposal up into a detailed design for us, and when we are content, we will issue them with the order to carry out the construction.

We have resolved to include a proposal for a pedestrian crossing on Hop Row as our bid for Local Highway Improvement Funding for 2016/17. This will need to be put forward in conjunction with the County Council and will need to meet their criteria for funding if it is to go ahead. Again, we will keep you informed of progress.

Street lighting is an integral part of road safety. You will all be aware that the County Council's contractor, Balfour Beatty, has recently replaced and upgraded the lighting on the main road network within the village. We also have our own Parish lights in certain areas and we have recently resolved to carry out our own programme of upgrades on these. If anyone feels that there is an area, which is in need of better lighting, we would be pleased to hear from you so that we can investigate.
