



Have your say on the County Council's budget



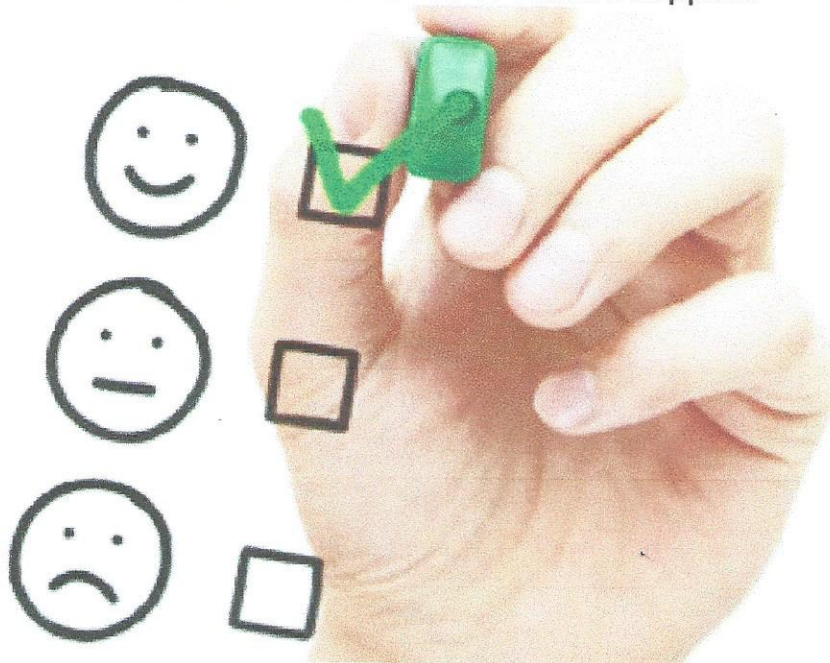

Residents across Cambridgeshire are being asked for their input in the setting of the County Council's budget for 2016/17.

Cuts in funding from central government coupled with increased demand and inflation means that we need to save £114 million over the next five years, on top of the £200million in savings we've already made.

Next year we need to save £45million - that's the equivalent of 9% of our entire budget.

More service cuts are inevitable but we want to do all we can to ensure that people and communities continue to receive support.
